The site he chose was 268ha of vineyards on the banks of the Waihopai River, on the southern side of the Wairau Valley. From here, Brent started Marisco Vineyards and achieved international success with his wines.

### Tasting Notes

Striking aromas of blackcurrant leaf and tropical fruit. The flavoursome palate is driven by gooseberry and stone fruit flavours, a striking balance between fruit concentration and freshness with great length of flavour.
