### Product Information

In 1990 Ron and his wife Jamie, bought their first vineyard and in 1995 McManis Family Vineyards was formed with the purpose-built winery arriving by the end of the Millennium. Now the McManis family own over 2,600 acres between the Ripon area and Lodi in California's northern interior region.

### Tasting Notes

The Chardonnay from McManis Family Vineyards has a vibrant hue, and is light straw in colour. The nose of the wine is a beautiful blend of pear, peach, lychee and tropical fruit. Notes of vanilla and toast are contributed from French oak aging. A richly textured offering of melon, pear and pineapple flavours on the palate with a long finish and well-balanced acidity.
